



Myrick Park Center Updates Due to COVID-19

Phase II Reopening: Updated July 24, 2020



At the Myrick Park Center, the health and safety of our community, guests, and staff are of the utmost importance. WisCorps continues to closely monitor the changing situation of COVID-19 and evolve our prevention and response plan accordingly.

Reservations

- We are now operating at 25% of our maximum capacity for all reservations through 2020. We will reevaluate this fall and make changes as needed. 25% capacity is as follows: Entire Facility 109, Marshview Rm 37, Atrium 52, Marshview Rm + Atrium 89, La Crosse Rm 10, Discovery Rm 10
- We, as well as federal, state, and local health departments, **strongly recommend requiring your guests to wear a face covering and to practice physical distancing.**
- We are open for scheduled reservations with additional safety policies and protocol in place.
- We continue to accept new reservations.
- We continue to offer scheduled on-site or virtual tours of the facility for weddings and events.
- We continue to offer the option to any 2020 reservations to reschedule their date to 2021.

Environmental Education

- Environmental educators are making decisions about the continuation of summer day camp programs on a week-by-week basis, the Wednesday before camp. Our environmental education team is communicating closely with the families registered for programs.
- No “drop-in” public programs are being offered on-site at this time.
